The main attraction at the **NaDEET Urban Sustainability Centre** is a model house. Inside visitors explore issues affecting the average Namibian household in practicing a sustainable lifestyle. In the open plan kitchen/ living room, visitors will discover how this “family” is practicing energy and water efficiency, using alternative resources and managing the household waste. In addition topics such as nutrition, transport and gardening can be explored by conducting activities and experiments.

Through educator-led programmes and self-guided activities, the **NaDEET Urban Sustainability Centre** aims to challenge our assumptions about the impact of our lifestyle choices and to offer ideas to finding suitable everyday solutions to environmental problems.

The town of Swakopmund and its surrounding unique natural habitats will be fully utilised as an “outdoor classroom” through practical, hands-on environmental learning that is fun and relevant to all ages.

Intended visitors: The general public, schoolchildren and tourists

Programmes: Self-guided tour with activity guides, guided tours, school programmes

Potential reach: 8,000 schoolchildren; 5,000 tourist and adult visitors per annum
